Preparing students for post-secondary locally and abroad

Upon completion of the program, students earn a French Immersion Certificate and are prepared and encouraged to write the *diplôme d'études en langue française (DEL F B2)* exam—an international diploma officially awarded by the French Ministry of Education to certify the French language skills of candidates from outside of France.

The DELF exam gives students a competitive edge when applying to French post-secondary institutions including Campus Saint-Jean—a faculty of the University of Alberta.
