Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update

The health, safety and well-being of exhibitors and attendees is our **top priority**. We are closely monitoring the direction from Alberta Health Services, the Public Health Agency of Canada and the World Health Organization. Alberta Health Services has assessed the public health risk associated with the Coronavirus (COVID-19) and has determined the risk to Albertans is currently low.

As a result, The Edmonton Boat and Sportsmen's Show will be continuing as planned.

In addition to regular health and safety procedures, the following additional measures are being implemented for the Edmonton Boat and Sportsmen's Show.

- The Edmonton Expo Centre has installed additional alcohol- based hand sanitizer stations in key high-traffic areas
- Additional cleaning staff has been scheduled to allow for enhanced cleaning in the lobbies, common areas, food service areas and washrooms. The best cleaning disinfectants against the virus are being used
- The Edmonton Expo Centre has installed signage in washrooms reminding attendees of hygiene recommendations

Rest assured that we are working closely with the Edmonton Expo Centre and remaining in contact with Alberta Health Services to monitor this situation.
