
## **High School Diploma**

## myPass

- MyPass is an Alberta Education selfservice website for students to:
  - Order high school transcripts
  - View diploma exam marks
  - Register to write or rewrite diploma exams
  - View Detailed Academic Report
  - View progress towards diploma
  - Order copies of their diploma
  - Must not use a school email address

## Alexander Rutherford Scholarship

 Apply once your official high school transcript marks are available and when you are enrolled in full-time postsecondary studies. If you have ever received a Merit or Honours certificate, you qualify.

Note: Alberta Student Aid must confirm your full-time enrolment at a post-secondary school before your aware can be paid

 You will still receive your cheque even if you attend post-secondary education outside Alberta

  - Caps & gowns will go home with each graduate after the ceremony




#### **DANCE & PROGRAM**

  - If you require additional tickets, please fill out google form to be put on the waitlist
    - If there are remaining tickets, they will be sold to those on a waitlist









